Requests - Architectural Application Process

- 1. *Prior to any alteration, addition or improvement*, SVM Member must submit their request in writing using the Architectural Application.
- 2. Requests must comply with the Association's Bill of Assurances, By-Laws, Rules of Conduct and Safety, as well as any City and/or State regulations.
- 3. Completed Applications are to be submitted to the Board for the Board's subsequent review and decision.
- 4. The SVM Member will be notified in writing within thirty (30) days of request of this Application and required attachments of the Board decision. Any missing attachments or required information will delay the 30 day response period until the receipt of the required materials.
