



## Luminaries – Saturday, December 10<sup>th</sup>

**The POA Board invites everyone to join in our neighborhood Holiday celebration.**

We will gather at the park at 09:30 AM on Saturday, December 10<sup>th</sup>, to add the sand and candles to the paper bags that everyone is working on folding at present. Then we will place the bags about 4 feet apart around the lakes, on the dam, and on the surrounding roads. Coffee, juice, and donuts will be provided by the POA.

At about 5:00 PM, everyone will begin lighting the candles in their area. Candles should burn for about 8 hours. On Sunday everyone will help with the clean-up by dumping sand out of bags, and picking up the metal wick stand and bags.

After lighting candles, we generally gather a group in the park to enjoy singing Christmas songs around the fire and viewing the Luminaries. All are welcome. Please come share the Spirit of the Holidays!
