Important rules at the beach are: 1) no dogs or pets inside the fence area, 2) no glass containers, 3) no profanity, please! 4) Fulton Park closes at 10:00 p.m. 5) fishing is permitted in Lake #1 and Lake #2 outside the swim area.

Issues and Concerns

We receive a number of phone calls regarding concerns in Spring Valley Manor. Here is a list of some of the calls and the city ruling or ordinance:

Are 4-wheelers, golf carts and mo-peds allowed on city streets?

Per Officer Nellums at the LR Police Dep't, the answer is "only vehicles that are licensed by the state are considered street legal." So if your vehicle (mo-ped, ATV, etc.) has a license plate issued by the State of Arkansas, and is on your vehicle, you are good to go!

Do pets need to be walked on a leash?

Yes. The City of LR Ordinances clearly states that all dogs should be confined on or off your property. For more information regarding city dog ordinances go to www.littlerock.org and click on the "municipal code" tab. Search for "dog" to find the section entitled "Article II. - Dogs" which starts at Sec. 6-14 through 6-21. There is also information about the maximum number of dogs allowed (4,) and information on "vicious" breeds and permits.
